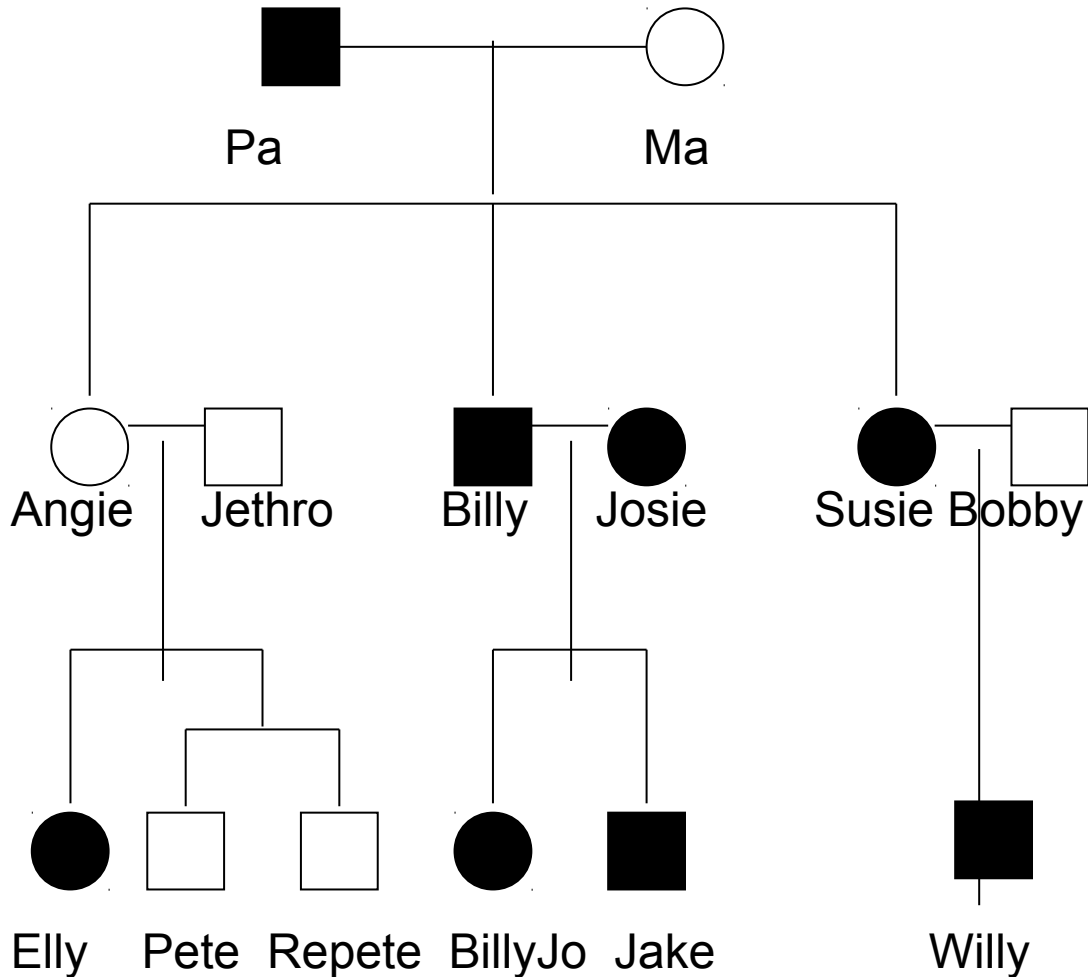


## A PEDIGREE OF POLYDACTYLY
